Three nights of I-10 closures scheduled for next week while crews set bridge beams at the I-10/Sunland interchange.

Did you know: The I-10/Sunland interchange is the most complex section of the entire six-mile **GO 10** project to build. Please follow the speed limit and don't drive distracted.

I-10 & Sunland

Daytime

Tuesday, May 30 through Friday, June 2
9 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day

- The left lane on I-10 in both directions will close between Buena Vista and Sunland Park. Crews are constructing new bridge columns in the area. [Map 1]

Overnight

Tuesday, May 30 and Wednesday, May 31
9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- I-10 in both directions will close **completely** at the Sunland Park Exit (Exit 13).
Detour: Traffic will be detoured onto the ramps alongside I-10. Follow detour signs in place.
Crews will be setting beams for the new turnaround lanes at the Sunland Park Overpass. [Map 2]

Overnight

Thursday, June 1
9 p.m. to 6 a.m. the next morning

- I-10 Westbound will close **completely** at the Sunland Park Exit (Exit 13).
- The Sunland Park Entrance Ramp to I-10 Westbound will close.

Detour: I-10 Westbound traffic will exit at Sunland Park (Exit 13), take North Mesa Street (SH 20) to the North Mesa/I-10 interchange where traffic may enter I-10 Westbound.

Crews will be setting beams for the new turnaround lanes at the Sunland Park Overpass. [Map 3]

- The two-lane Sunland Park Exit Ramp (Exit 13, Westbound) will be reduced to one lane. This closure is necessary to give crews access to the work site. [No Map]

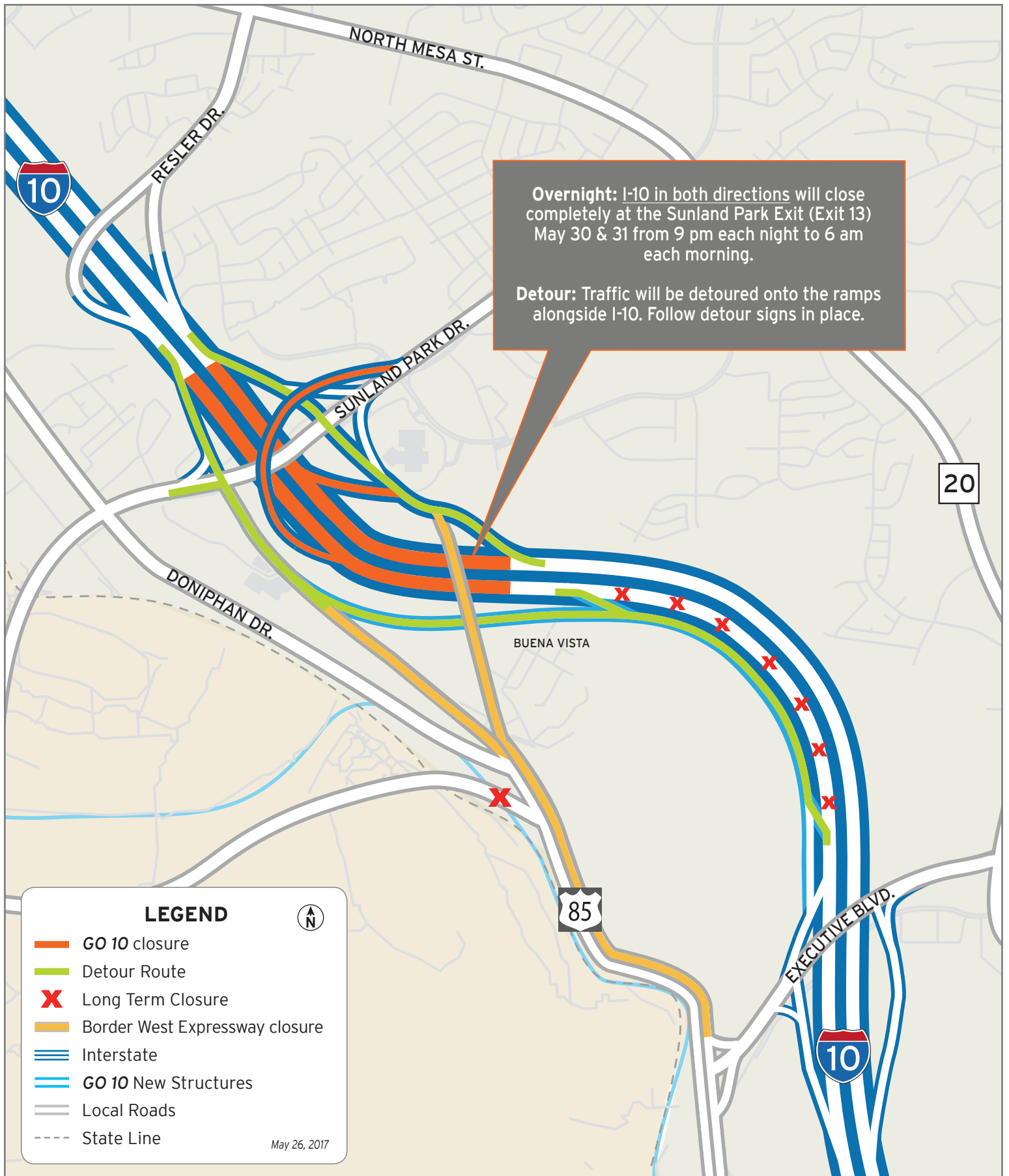

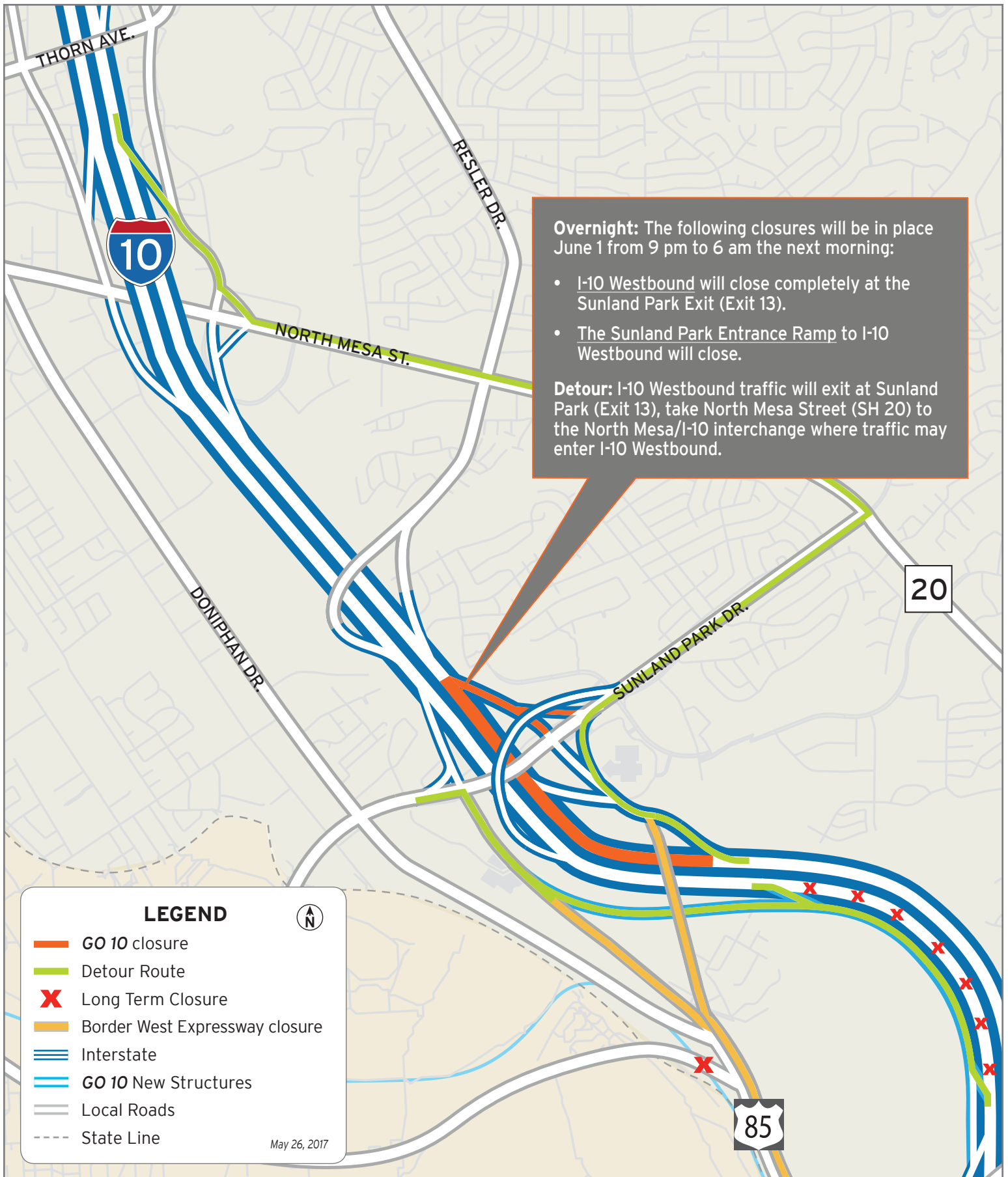




Full Closure of I-10 at Sunland
